Coronavirus Symptoms - What to Do.

If your child is showing any of the following symptoms you must keep them at home and book a test. The rest of the household also needs to self-isolate.

- ◆ A high temperature,
- ◆ A new, continuous cough—this means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if you usually have a cough, it may be worse than usual),
- ◆ A loss or change to their sense of smell or taste.

Please contact the school and inform us that your child has symptoms. We will then inform public health who are tracking cases of the virus. Once your child has been tested inform us of the results.

If you do not get them tested they must self isolate at home for 10 days.

No one else in the household needs to isolate if you have been double jabbed or your other children are under 16, even if your child has tested Positive.
